

WORK SAFETY RULES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

To prevent the spread of SARS-CoV-2 virus, precautions should be taken in everyday work and in contacts between employees.

1 PROTECTIVE CLOTHING



WORKWEAR

(i.e. apron, suit, trousers) should be changed after each day of work and handed over to the laundry service.



PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT

The protective apron used to protect personal clothing should be changed at the end of the day.

EMPLOYEE CLOAKROOM

Aprons hanging outside lockers that are not in garment bags should be handed over to the laundry service. Shoes outside the lockers should be removed from the cloakroom.



Particular care should be taken when removing personal protective equipment to avoid accidental contamination – please follow the ECDC guidelines*.

2 CONTACTS BETWEEN INDIVIDUALS AT WORK AND IN SOCIAL ROOMS

USING SOCIAL ROOMS

- limit to an absolute minimum
- limit the number of people in the room at the same time (maximum two persons)
- maintain a safe distance of at least 1.5 m
- before and after meals wipe down the area with an available disinfectant
- wash your hands according to the instructions before and after meals
- do not leave food unprotected
- do not leave dirty unwashed dishes and cutlery in the sink or on the tables
- dishes and cutlery should be washed thoroughly in warm water using dishwashing liquids – it is recommended to soak the dishes in boiling water
- clean dishes and cutlery should be stored in closed cupboards



- limit the contact to an absolute minimum
- maintain the safe distance of minimum 1.5 metres
- do not arrange social meetings
- do not shake hands
